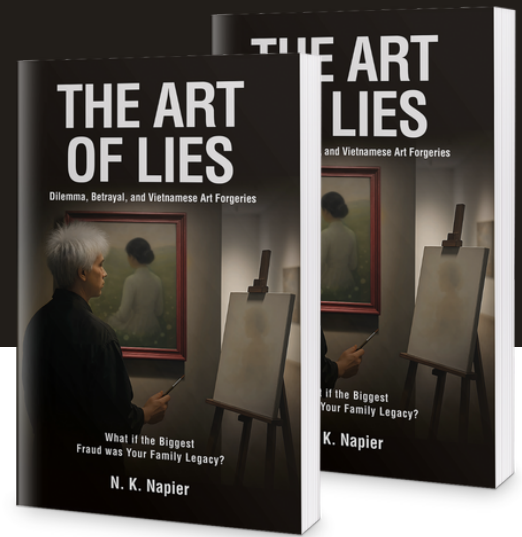


THE ART OF LIES
